## PIG Mercury Spill Vacuum Kit

## **Instructions**

**NOTE:** This product is only effective for elemental (metallic) mercury.

- 1. Always wear proper personal protective equipment.
- 2. Insert one vial onto the nozzle of the mercury hand pump vacuum.
- 3. Extend flexible tubing. Place stainless steel tip into mercury spill droplets and depress the lever on the hand pump.

**NOTE:** For the most efficient operation, do not hold the hand pump vacuum higher than necessary above the mercury spill. Do not fill the collection tube closer than ½" below grommet. If necessary, use the scoop/spatula to help gather small mercury droplets.

- 4. When collection is complete, extend the tube above the pump and depress the lever on the hand pump to evacuate any remaining mercury.
- 5. After mercury has been collected into the mercury collection vial, carefully remove it from the nozzle of the hand pump.
- 6. Cut approximately 6" of butyl rubber tape and cover grommet on mercury collection vial.
- 7. Use PIG Mercury Cleanup Wipers to wipe remaining residue with disposable wipers.
- 8. Place used mercury collection vial, scoop/spatula, disposable gloves, and used wipes into provided disposal bag.
- 9. Place hand pump into empty plastic zip closure bag provided. This will minimize potential for cross-contamination.
