

PIG Mercury Spill Kit in Bucket

Instructions

NOTE: This product is only effective for elemental (metallic) mercury.

1. Put on gloves and always wear proper personal protective equipment.
2. Sprinkle PIG Mercury Absorbent Powder in a circle around the spill to prevent mercury from spreading. The absorbent powder contained in this PIG Mercury Spill Kit will bond with droplets of mercury, transforming them into a solid material and making handling and disposal safer
3. Pour more absorbent powder directly onto the spill, if needed, working from the outside inward until mercury is completely covered. **(fig. A)**
4. If the mercury is not fully absorbed within 2 to 3 minutes, use the provided plastic scraper to thoroughly mix the powder with the mercury.
5. Remove the solid material by sweeping it up with the broom and dustpan found in the kit. **(fig. B)**
6. Use PIG Mercury Cleanup Wipers to wipe the surface and remove any residue. **(fig. C)**
7. Place all used absorbents, dustpan, used wipers, and gloves in the disposal bag and tie closed. Place the bag in the spill kit container and close the lid.

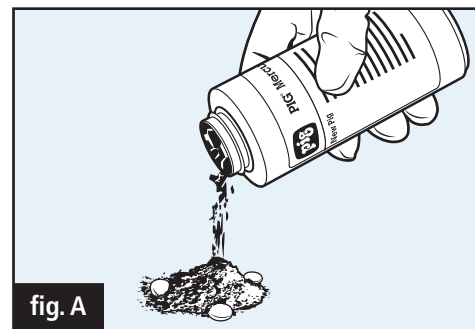
