

Touchless High-Capacity Hand Sanitizer Dispenser

Instructions

Included Parts & Accessories

- (4) D Batteries
- (2) Keys for fuel cap
- (4) Leveling feet

Tools Required

- Phillips screwdriver

Filling/Refilling Instructions

1. Use key to unlock fuel cap, then twist to remove from back of unit (**fig. A**).
2. Fill unit with liquid or gel hand sanitizer (**fig. B**) while monitoring exterior window below fill neck to avoid overfilling.
3. Replace cap and lock unit. Be careful NOT to overtighten the fuel cap.

Priming Instructions

Unit must be filled to approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ capacity prior to priming.

1. Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the four screws on top of unit.
2. Remove top plate.
3. Press red prime button on pump one time (**fig. C**); listen for pump to click as fluid starts rising through the uptake tube.
4. Repeat step 3 until the spout dispenses liquid. (It may take up to 6 tries on initial priming.)
5. Replace the top plate and secure with screws.

⚠ WARNINGS

- Use hand sanitizer dispenser only as directed
- Do not use in areas where dispensers may be exposed to direct flame and create a combustion hazard
- Hand sanitizer is intended for external use only; in case of accidental ingestion, call the Poison Control Center hotline at 1-800-222-1222
- Always transfer a filled unit vertically, using a dolly

Troubleshooting

Motor is running but unit is NOT dispensing

- Hand sanitizer reservoir may be empty — check the exterior window to determine if the unit needs a refill; refill to $\frac{3}{4}$ capacity and reprime
- Hose fitting may have become disconnected
- Pump may not be primed correctly (repeat Priming Instructions above)

Motor is NOT running and unit is NOT dispensing:

- Battery charge may be too low to power unit; locate battery box inside top of unit and insert new batteries
- Batteries may not be properly installed; check +/- alignment

Use & Maintenance

- Always use fresh batteries; replace alkaline batteries with lithium batteries when operating outdoors in winter weather
- For use on uneven surfaces, insert leveling feet through holes in bottom of unit (feet are threaded, turn by hand to adjust height)
- Holes in base allow permanent installation (hardware not included)
