Instructions

- 1. Do not apply if raining or if rain is expected within 24 hours of application. Optimal temperature for spray paint application is between 50°F and 90°F.
- 2. Using a broom and/or paint scraper, remove debris from surface at curb or adjacent to the drain. PIG Storm Drain Stencil can be applied to concrete or asphalt. Do not apply on top of storm drain grate.
- 3. Place the stencil on flat surface. If needed, tape corners to stabilize.
- 4. Spray the paint approximately 8 inches from stencil surface. Depending on coverage, two applications may be required.
- 5. Remove stencil and wipe clean for reuse.
- 6. Paint cures in 60 minutes. Allow to cure during a period without rain.
