



Drum Funnel or Drum Lid?

You have liquid waste.

Tight-head drums containing process liquids or hazardous waste need to meet closed container regs. **PIG Burples Steel Funnels** provide easy access and fast pouring with no splashback.



You have solid waste.

Open-head drums containing solids like used rags and absorbents or punctured aerosol cans need to meet closed container regs. **PIG Latching Drum Lids** provide easy access and seal tightly to keep vapors in.



Know the regs.

EPA regulation **40 CFR 262.16(b)(2)(ii)** and **40 CFR 262.17(a)(1)(iv)** says containers holding wastes with VOC's must be "kept closed, except when necessary to add or remove hazardous wastes." EPA regulation **40 CFR 264.1086(c)** requires that your drums be "equipped with a cover and closure devices that form a continuous barrier over the container openings such that when the cover and closure devices are secured in the closed position there are no visible holes, gaps or other open spaces in the interior of the container."
