

## SPILL REPORTING GUIDE

## USE THESE GUIDELINES TO ALERT THE CORRECT PERSONNEL, AUTHORITIES AND AGENCIES ABOUT A SPILL AT YOUR FACILITY

Notify our onsite spill response team to begin cleanup
Call our contracted response team (if applicable) Phone:
Make the following notifications:
Local Emergency Response Agency Phone:  In many communities, this notification can be made by calling 9-1-1
State Emergency Response Commission Phone:  In most states, this is a division of the state Emergency Management Agency
• National Response Center 1-800-424-8802 The NRC is staffed by US Coast Guard Personnel 24 hours a day
Phone operators at each of these agencies are likely to ask for the following information:
Date and time of the incident
Facility Location (address, latitude, longitude, township, county)
Name of individual reporting the incident
Telephone number
Type of material discharged
Estimate of the total quantity discharged (gallons)
The source of the discharge
Media being affected (air, water, land)
Actions being used to stop, remove or mitigate the effects of the discharge
Any damages or injuries caused by the discharge
Whether or not an evacuation will be needed
Names of individuals and or organizations that have been contacted (NRC, facility personnel, state agencies, county agencies, etc.)
