THE TOP 5 BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES TO STOP THE SPILL

1 SECONDARY CONTAINMENT

Keep spills in a confined area and away from drains to prevent pollution

2 DRAIN PROTECTION

Seal drains from harmful liquids to prevent releases

3 PASSIVE DEVICES

Capture sediment and debris from parking lots and other paved surfaces

4 SPILL PREPAREDNESS

Plan ahead to identify hazards and outline spill response procedures

5 TRAINING

Prepare employees for a spill emergency
