1 SECONDARY CONTAINMENT Keep spills in a confined area and away from drains to prevent pollution

2 DRAIN PROTECTION

Seal drains from harmful liquids to prevent releases



Capture sediment and debris from parking lots and other paved surfaces

4 SPILL PREPAREDNESS Plan ahead to identify hazards and outline spill response procedures

> **5 TRAINING** Prepare employees for a spill emergency
